

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-**

**54**

**OFFERED BY MR. LARSEN OF WASHINGTON**

At the end of subtitle B of title IX, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 9\_\_\_.** **SENSE OF CONGRESS ON THE ELECTRO-**  
2 **MAGNETIC SPECTRUM SUPERIORITY STRAT-**  
3 **EGY.**

4 It is the sense of Congress that—

5 (1) the Department of Defense released the  
6 Electromagnetic Spectrum Superiority Strategy (Oc-  
7 tober 2020) and an Implementation Plan for such  
8 strategy (August 2021);

9 (2) the purpose of the Electromagnetic Spec-  
10 trum Superiority Strategy is to align electromagnetic  
11 spectrum activities across the Department of De-  
12 fense to solve persistent gaps in the ability of the  
13 United States to project, achieve, and sustain elec-  
14 tromagnetic spectrum superiority against adversaries  
15 and peer competitors, most notably Russia and Peo-  
16 ple’s Republic of China;

17 (3) a goal of the Electromagnetic Spectrum Su-  
18 periority Strategy is to “Establish Effective EMS

1 Governance” to unify Department of Defense-wide  
2 electromagnetic spectrum enterprise activities, de-  
3 velop a continuous process improvement culture, and  
4 promote policies that support Department of De-  
5 fense electromagnetic spectrum capabilities and op-  
6 erations;

7 (4) electromagnetic spectrum superiority under-  
8 pins each of the four priorities of the 2022 National  
9 Defense Strategy of the Department of Defense;

10 (5) the projecting, achievement, and  
11 sustainment of electromagnetic spectrum superiority  
12 is inherently a joint operational mission that is fun-  
13 damental to the success of military missions carried  
14 out by the United States and its allies across all  
15 warfighting domains;

16 (6) electromagnetic spectrum operations leader-  
17 ship in the Pentagon must be consolidated and un-  
18 ambiguous to address persistent gaps in coordina-  
19 tion of joint electronic warfare among the services  
20 and fragmentation in guidance from leadership in  
21 the Department of Defense; and

22 (7) the Secretary of Defense—

23 (A) should provide to Congress an unclas-  
24 sified version of the Implementation Plan for

1 the Electromagnetic Spectrum Superiority  
2 Strategy in all future updates to the plan; and

3 (B) as part of implementing the Electro-  
4 magnetic Spectrum Superiority Strategy,  
5 should—

6 (i) strengthen governance reforms to  
7 ensure necessary senior operational leader-  
8 ship; and

9 (ii) provide a coherent response to  
10 persistent gaps in joint electromagnetic  
11 spectrum operations across the areas of  
12 Doctrine, Organization, Training, Materiel,  
13 Leadership, Personnel, Facilities and Pol-  
14 icy (DOTMLPF-P);
