

AOC Foundation Articles of Incorporation

I, the undersigned, do hereby form a non-stock corporation under the provisions of Chapter 2, Title 13.1 of the Code of Virginia, for such cases made and provided and by this our Articles of Incorporation set forth the following:

<u>First</u>: The name of the corporation shall be AOC EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION, INC. It shall be authorized to do business as the AOC Foundation.

<u>Second</u>: The registered office of this corporation shall be located in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, the post office address being 1000 North Payne Street, Suite 200, Alexandria, Virginia 22314. The name of the registered agent is National Registered Agents, Inc., 4001 North Ninth Street, Suite 227, Arlington, VA 22203. The business office of the corporation is the same as the registered office of the corporation.

<u>Third</u>: Said corporation is organized to advance the legacy of the Electronic Warfare professional, to advance the educational requirements of the profession of the Electronic Warfare, and to support the members and chapter and membership programs of the Association of Old Crows, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Fourth: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance to the purposes set forth in Article Three hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

<u>Fifth</u>: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
