## **Governance Committee**

1. <u>Committee Purpose</u>: Responsible for the ongoing review and recommendations to enhance the quality and future viability of the Board.

## 2. Duties:

- Serve as the Board's Parliamentarian
- Conduct a biennial review of the the AOC's OpMans
- Review Board practices and suggest improvements as needed to ensure effective governance practices.
- Assess/determine appropriate composition of the Board, to include size and collective attributes.
- Review/update the Board's roles, responsibilities and focus areas.
- Maintain and/or prepare amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws in accordance with the appropriate laws and the wishes of the membership and the BOD.
- Counsel the President and the Board on items of Association business affected by the Constitution.
- Consult with the AOC legal counsel as required to ensure compliance with all appropriate laws and statutes.
- Review OpMan revisions (or new submissions) prior to presentation to the Board for approval to ensure that they are not in conflict with the Constitution or By-Laws.
- Review/approve petitions for new chapters.
- Lead the development of Committee Charters
- Consult with the Executive Director to ensure that appropriate governance topics and/or specific items are covered during the initial BoD member orientation.
- Design and oversee governance related new Executive Director's orientation.
- 3. Chair: Appointed by the President
- 4. Members: Committee Chair.
- 5. <u>Staff Support</u>: Executive Director
- 6. <u>Required Financial Resources</u>: To be determined annually and requested if required.
- 7. Duration: Ongoing
- 8. <u>Communication/Updates to BoD</u>: Regular reports at Board meetings on status of governance actions to include proposed changes to Constitution, By-laws and/or OpMans

## 9. Participation by Non-Committee Members:

- Members submit proposed Constitution or By-laws changes to the committee for review prior to vote by the Board and membership.
- OpMan owners submit proposed revisions to the committee, which will review for compliance with the Constitution and By-laws prior to vote by the Board.
- Staff director of membership operations forwards petitions for new chapters to the committee chair for review/approval.
