- Goal: To have an actionable plan in place at the National and Chapter level which is both flexible and sustainable.
- The monetary size of the program at the National Level should be \$100K
- The recommended monetary size of the program at the Chapter Level should be:
  - Small Chapter - \$1k
  - Medium Chapter - \$6K
  - Large Chapter \$6K

- National Program Distribution would be:
  - High School (Junior/Senior) - \$40K with \$5K per student
  - College (All Grades) - \$40K with \$5K per student
  - Postgraduate (All Degrees/Certifications) - \$20K with \$5K per student
  - Funds could help with travel or conference costs, schoolbooks not just tuition.
- International – How do we support
  - Give out cash awards with certificates to support students.

We should be supporting our community – it's the right thing to do

- AOC Funds Allocation Resources:
  - \$200K per Calendar Year ( from AOC Symposia/Events )
  - 100K from AOC Reserve Funds to get started
  - Years AOC Has a surplus a percentage of the surplus would go to the Foundation
  - TBD Amount from Industry, Other Organizations, and Membership
    - Install a Community Partnership Organization with Annual Dues of:
      - \$250K for Small Business
      - \$500K for Large Business
