Served over 10 Years in Military Leadership positions in the Acquisition Corps that focused on Multi Domain Capabilities to include Electronic Warfare. Positions included service as the Deputy Director for Acquisition at DISA which included advising and overseeing PEO Spectrum efforts, Project Manager for Electronic Warfare and Cyber (PM EW&C) which provided Electronic Warfare, SIGINT, Offensive Cyber and Offensive Space to the Army, Director of Advanced Concepts and Technology for ARCYBER which advocated for operational RF delivered capabilities, Product Manager Information Warfare which provided Offensive Cyber and RF Enabled Cyber capabilities (initiated the programs that are now the Joint Common Access Platform (JCAP) and Joint Development Environment (JDE)

I have been active and lifetime member of AOC, AUSA and AFCEA for a number of years. All of these organizations have an overlap of interest in capabilities operating in the EMS. Experience as a Project Manager developing and fielding multi domain capabilities (Cyber, EW, SIGINT and Space) have given me a unique and holistic perspective on how EW best serves the Warfighter. As an Acquisition Officer, I understand the importance of stakeholders and champions and the impact they can have on efforts. I have been passionate about providing Warfighters the best capabilities possible and was awarded the 2019 Army PM of the Year and the 2021 Stanley B. Hall Executive Management Award from AOC for my efforts.

AOC would benefit due to my experience and linkages with the Army’s Electronic Warfare, SIGINT (Both Army and NSA), Cyber (Both Army and CYBERCOM) and Space communities. I have been an active panel member, moderator and worked on planning both the CEMA and National Conferences for over 6 years. For instance, last year I was able to gain the first DISA participation on an AOC panel in recent memory to discuss EMBM, the EMSO contribution to CJADC2. As an Acquisition Officer for over 20 years, I understand acquisition pathways, PPBE, requirement processes and how they impact industry. This experience will help AOC provide experiences that provide a return on investment to our members.

COL (Ret) Kevin E. Finch currently works as an ISR/EW Senior Associate at Booz Allen Hamilton. During his 28-year U.S. Army career, Kevin served in leadership positions at multiple organizations, including the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA), Headquarters Department of the Army, Program Executive Office Intelligence, Electronic Warfare and Sensors (PEO IEW&S), and Army Cyber Command (ARCYBER), focusing on delivering Electronic Warfare, Cyber, and Space capabilities. While serving as the Project Manager for Electronic Warfare and Cyber (PM EW&C), Kevin was selected as the 2019 Army PM of the Year and earned the 2021 Stanley B. Hall Executive Management Award from AOC. Kevin has been a vocal champion, insisting on the use of Modular Open System Approaches and SOSA-based solutions. While at PM EW&C, he focused on fielding Electronic Warfare Quick Reaction Capabilities for use in INDOPACOM and EUCOM and developed multiple Electronic Warfare Programs of Record to address near-peer threats. Kevin has continued to advocate for Electromagnetic Battle Management (EMBM), RF-enabled cyber, and Space EW capabilities.
