Eric Colon served 31 years in the US Army and currently is the Director of Electronic Warfare and Cyber Strategic Solutions at Corvus LLC. His previous position was the Senior Electronic Warfare Subject Matter Expert at the Department of the Army Strategic Operation G 3/5/7 Strategy Policy and Plan. He was responsible for supporting the Army warfighting transformation by integrating, prioritizing, and synchronizing multi-domain, data-enabled warfighting systems, as well as operational requirements focused on the electromagnetic spectrum and consisting of Information Dominance, Cyber Electromagnetic Activities (CEMA), and electromagnetic spectrum management operations.

Eric also served as a touchpoint for Joint Staff J-7 Analytic Research Program, “Quantum Threats to the 2030 Joint Force,” where he was responsible for advising the staff on determining the optimal mix of tools to prevent adversaries’ encryption and decryption of exploited data that could provide vulnerability information on weapon systems or C2. Prior to becoming a consultant, he was the Technical Advisor to the senior Electronic Warfare Technician at Army Cyber Command, G-39, and he was responsible for the coordination and integration of EW training strategies and managing the Army Cyber Operations Training Strategy, the 915th Cyber Warfare Battalion and the Multi Domain Task Force equipping plan. During his Army service, Eric deployed to CENTCOM AOR and has completed multiple deployments in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and IRAQI FREEDOM. Eric is currently pursuing his PhD in Information Technology with a concentration in Blockchain and cryptography from the University of the Cumberland.
