Jeffrey "Fisch" Fischer is one of the most unique, strongest, and well positioned advocates for Electronic Warfare (EW) in the world today. Currently, Fisch sits on two boards, authors action thrillers, founded a disabled veteran charity, is a news persona for TV and periodicals such as CBS, BBC, The Hill, Newsweek, The Kyiv Post, and others. Jeff is a heavily sought expert on a gamut of security issues, to include his passion: EW.

Commissioning into the Air Force in 1990, Fisch served as EC-130H Compass Call EWO and was hand-picked as the first exchange officer from that platform to fly Navy EA-6B Prowlers off the USS *Constellation*. He is one of a handful to fly both platforms in combat. Given his two Pentagon tours in EW requirements and programming, Fisch holds a firm understanding of spectrum warfare at both operational and staff levels. After his staff tours, Jeff's career broadened into two senior US diplomat positions in Europe, then retiring from NATO Special Operations Headquarters as a senior officer.

Since his welcome into AOC when he won the old Electronic Warfare Schoolhouse's 'Super Crow Award,' Jeff's long-standing relationship with AOC is impressive. Fisch is a two-time AOC national award winner, has penned JED articles to include a cover story in September 2011, and is one of the most listened to guests on AOC's "From the Crows' Nest" podcast, according to the host. Further, he's lectured at AOC forums, to include congressional staffers, AOC Europe and the AOC 2023 International Symposium and Convention in Washington, DC.
