

Future Leaders Development Committee

1. Committee Purpose: The Future Leaders Committee is established to create and oversee a program tailored to the needs and interests of young professionals within our association. The program aims to provide educational, networking, and career development opportunities to help young professionals advance in their careers and become engaged, active members of the association.
2. Duties: This committee will focus on providing a range of professional development opportunities and networking events for young professionals within the association, contributing to their growth and engagement within the organization.
3. Chair: Appointed by the President
4. Members: The committee will consist of a diverse group of association members, including both young professionals and experienced professionals. The committee should include representatives from different industries or sectors within the association to ensure a well-rounded perspective. The committee shall be comprised of, in addition to the Chairman, not less than two members as needed.
5. Staff Support: Raleigh Leavitt
6. Required Financial Resources: As needed with the approval of the President and the BoD.
7. Duration: The committee will be considered ad hoc, with a flexible duration based on the success and ongoing need for the Future Leaders Program. The committee's continuation will be assessed periodically and determined by the association's leadership.
8. Communication/Updates to BoD: The committee will provide regular reports and updates to the association's board to ensure transparency and alignment with the association's strategic plan.
9. Meeting Frequency: The committee will meet regularly, typically once a month, but at least once a quarter, to discuss progress, plan upcoming events, and address any challenges or concerns. Additional meetings may be scheduled as needed.
10. Participation by Non-Committee Members: As required and agreed by the President and Chair.
