Security Ad-Hoc Committee Charter

 Committee Purpose: Established to ensure AOC Security Policy follows necessary government guidelines and meets the Association's security access needs to meet stakeholder and membership requirements.

2. Duties:

- a. Review security requirements and procedures for AOC HQ
- b. Integrate security requirements with strategic planning and evolving Association needs.
 - If we diversify to provide more Professional/Technical COE support to stakeholders assure our Security and Physical Infrastructure support.
 - ii. Develop enabling capabilities to meet Strategic Goals
 - 1. Example: Help integrate international participation by working with NATO (with appropriate NATO clearances)
- 3. Chair: Appointed by the President
- 4. <u>Members</u>: The Committee shall be composed of a Chairman and not less than one (1) other member.
- 5. Staff Support: Executive Director and/or FSO or other as assigned
- 6. Required Financial Resources: As needed
- 7. <u>Duration</u>: Duration of CRADA
- 8. <u>Communication/Updates to BoD</u>: Regular reports at Board meetings on the status of discussions/recommendations. EXCOM will determine if additional committee reports/updates are warranted
- 9. <u>Participation by Non-Committee Members</u>: The committee must be represented by AOC members in good standing.
