

## Education/Professional Development Committee Summary Report date: May 29, 2025

- Courses offered/planned since January 2025
  - Webinars: 10 offered; Three (3) scheduled with more being added regularly
    - Based on the minimal number of attendees during the months of July and August in 2024, summer webinars will not be offered.

## Strategic Partnerships in Development

- Southwest Research Institute (SwRI) Classified three (3)-day collateral SECRET with breakout at Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information (TS/SCI) course presented by Dr. Karen Haigh at SwRI San Antonio location. AOC to oversee registration and market to AOC audiences while gaining exposure to SwRI audiences, who could be potential new members. Capacity: 140
- West Virginia University (WVU) Threat Assets for Test and Evaluation (TATE) Workshop Unclassified four (4)-day workshop at the West Virgina University Campus, October 7-10. AOC to oversee event logistics and be marketed as the official workshop partner. AOC staff will be onsite to engage with event attendees, including having a membership booth/table for recruitment purposes. WVU will treat AOC as a contractor, providing compensation for all work completed by the AOC team. Capacity: 140
